This Friends Report is divided into 4 chapters.

Chapter 1 describes your temperaments and personalities. The issues described in Chapter 1 become particularly powerful if you have a close or long-lasting relationship. Idiosyncrasies or quirks in another person's personality do not bother us as much if our relationship is a casual one. For example, if one person is neat and tidy and the other is sloppy, this is more likely to become a concern if you depend on each other in a business partnership than if you are casual acquaintances.

Pay close attention to the issues described in Chapter 2 because these are the most important themes in

your relationship. For example, if themes of open communication and friendliness are emphasized, then you can count on this relationship growing into a close, long-lasting friendship. However, if friendliness and harmony between you are hardly mentioned at all, your relationship will be a more formal, less personal one and you probably won't think of one another as close friends. Note also that the material in Chapter 2 is presented roughly in order of importance, so that the material presented at the beginning of Chapter 2 is the most powerful.

Chapter 4 describes issues in your relationship of less importance than those presented in Chapter 2. Chapter 3 describes situations and circumstances that arise over time if your relationship is a long-lasting one.

If a statement appears to contradict another statement, then your roles are likely to alternate. For example, a statement that Jane is more aggressive than Mary, and another statement stating that Mary is more aggressive than Jane, means that you alternate roles, with Jane sometimes being the leader and Mary being the follower, and sometimes just the opposite. Also, read the statements carefully, as it is likely that a careful reading will reveal different kinds of aggressiveness or areas in which the aggressiveness is likely to express itself.

To make the most of this report, combine this astrological analysis with other things that you know about each other. For example, if your relationship is strictly business-related and close, personal friendship is unimportant to both of you, then it will not concern you if there is little warmth in the relationship. However, a lack of warmth and sympathy, or a tendency to be critical and judgmental of one another, is a more serious problem in a parent-child relationship. You may also want to order a Natal Report for each of you. The Natal Report describes your individual traits. The material in Chapters 2, 3 and 4 of this report describes the dynamics of your relationship, but does not describe your individual natures.

Your birth chart interpretation is based on the positions of the planets at the time of your birth. For the benefit of students of astrology, these positions, along with other technical information, are listed below:

Chapter 1 A Comparison of Temperaments and Life Styles that Affect Your Ability to Harmonize with Each Other

Jane's Sun in Libra and Mary's Sun in Leo:

Of the two of you, Mary is the stronger individual, and the balance of power may be somewhat lopsided in your relationship. Jane is more willing to compromise and accommodate others than Mary is, and Jane is also subtler, more diplomatic and indirect. Mary has a very strong ego and pride and Jane usually has the tact and delicacy not to offend Mary, so you are likely to get on well. However, Jane also has a strong sense of fairness, expects attention and favors to be reciprocated, and may balk at Mary's tendency to be self-centered. You share a strong interest in style, fashion, and aesthetics or appearances.

Jane's Moon in Libra and Mary's Moon in Capricorn:

Jane is a warm, affectionate person who needs people, and conversation, companionship, togetherness are very important to Jane. Mary is often emotionally reserved and not emotionally available, responsive, or demonstrative. Jane is rather dependent on friends, while Mary is more self-sufficient emotionally and/or afraid of neediness, dependency, and emotional vulnerability. Jane finds security in personal relationships, Mary finds it in work, accomplishment, and material success. Mary, in fact, takes life seriously and tends to work more than necessary, while Jane is more balanced and wants to spend time socializing or relaxing more than Mary does. Mary expects a friend to prove himself or herself, to be faithful and reliable, and it often takes time for Mary to open up and trust. Mary can be a bit cynical, whereas Jane is more idealistic. The two of you can be good friends, though your friendship may grow slowly.

Moon & Venus hard for Mary, soft or conj for Jane:

Both of you are very family-oriented, and devoted to your cherished friends also. Jane is generally well-loved, and enjoys an excellent rapport with women and children especially. Mary wants and needs closeness too, but sometimes does things which interfere with getting that closeness and nurturing, and sometimes overdoes it - being too solicitous and sweet or indulging in self-pity when others do not provide the desired tenderness and care, for instance.

Doing nurturing activities, such as giving one another massages, sharing meals, and providing emotional support should be a focus in your relationship.

Chapter 2 Major Themes in the Relationship: What Brought You Together

Mercury Mutually Aspects Uranus:

You inspire each other to think along new, creative lines and together you can devise very original and unusual ideas, products, and plans. Be wary of the tendency to be very impulsive when making joint decisions. Sometimes the two of you abruptly seize an opportunity, realizing later that you were swept away by the excitement and novelty of the idea, and the idea is not that practical or realistic.

Jane's Mercury Conjunct Mary's Uranus:

You inspire each other to develop original, creative ideas. Mary, especially, awakens, enlivens, or radically changes Jane's ideas and perspective. There is a strong impulsive quality too, and together you tend to make decisions impulsively. This is fun and exciting when the decisions are relatively harmless (for example, deciding to go somewhere together), but care is needed before making more important decisions (for example, suddenly deciding to form a business partnership).

Mary's Mercury Sextile Jane's Uranus:

You spark each other's wit and imagination, and you probably enjoy joking with each other. You bring out creative, inventive ideas in each other, and you develop original and creative ideas together.

Venus Mutually Aspects Neptune:

Your feelings for each other are rather dreamy and idealized, and it is doubtful that you have a very realistic view of each other. You are willing to give or give up a great deal for each other and, positively, you are quite tolerant, accepting, and forgiving toward one another. Negatively, you may reinforce any tendencies toward laziness, dependencies, or escapism.

Mary's Venus Sextile Jane's Neptune:*

You enjoy sharing music, art, or poetry with each other. Taking evening walks, listening to music together, and watching movies together are likely to be some of your favorite shared activities. You encourage one another to relax and perhaps to be lazy or passive. Also, you accept and appreciate one another, and readily overlook one another's weaknesses.

Venus Mutually Aspects Pluto:

A powerful, compelling fascination with one another is likely to draw you together, and you may love or hate one another with an intensity that is surprising even to you! The powerful feelings that you have for each other can be used to manipulate one another; and dominance, control, or jealousy easily become hot issues between you. Whether this is a brief encounter or a lifelong attachment, you will change one another profoundly.

*Jane's Venus Conjunct Mary's Pluto,
Mary's Venus Conjunct Jane's Pluto:*

There is a great deal of magnetic attraction between you which can interfere with your objectivity about one another, or with any professional relationship you might have. Deep feelings of either love and appreciation or distrust and repulsion are stirred up between you, but much of this may be played out behind the scenes or in subtle ways. You are likely to wonder why your feelings toward one another are so irrationally strong. Negatively, there is a tendency for either or both of you to manipulate the other and to use your friendship for selfish purposes. Positively, an unusually deep and close relationship can develop between you, one in which there are few secrets or superficial social masks to hide behind.

Jane's Asc. Conjunct Mary's Pluto:

Mary holds an unusually strong fascination for, and influence over, Jane. As you become closer, you discover that very little can be hidden from one another. Your subconscious motives, feelings, and desires are brought to light in this relationship, which is likely to profoundly change your attitudes towards yourselves. You are likely to feel either much more powerful, or heavily dominated by, your friend. This is an intense and revealing relationship!

Mary's Asc. Opposition Jane's Saturn:

There is a strong emphasis on responsibility, loyalty, and obligations in this relationship. Consequently, at times you feel confined and limited by each other. Mary, especially, may find that your friendship involves too many obligations and responsibilities. You can be very close, but you also rely too heavily on one another, and expect too much, exacting high standards on one another (especially Jane on Mary). Too much emphasis on your responsibilities or promises to one another can squeeze the warmth and fun out of your friendship.

Mary's Mars Conjunction Jane's Pluto:

You draw out of each other your deepest drives and desires. The two of you arouse a zeal and sense of mission in each other that makes it possible for you to jointly accomplish extraordinary tasks. However, your fears and anxieties are brought to the surface too, and there is no guarantee that your zealousness will produce positive, constructive results. You may become fanatical in an extreme and unbalanced manner. Also, jealousy and competition can be very volatile, disruptive, obsessive, and intense in this relationship.

Jane's Sun Sextile Mary's Sun:

There is a great deal of compatibility between you for you understand and are in harmony with one another's basic needs, aims, and approach to life. You build up, encourage, and affirm one another's worth and self-esteem, and you find one another's company very comfortable and natural. This is a mutually beneficial relationship.

Mary's Sun Sextile Jane's Mars:

You work together very well on projects, and you make an excellent partnership in any joint venture, sport, or business activity.

Mary's Asc. Square Jane's Sun:

You often unintentionally "rub each other the wrong way". Your personal tastes and interests are frequently different. If you try to convince each other that your life style, tastes, and interests are better than your friend's, then you will frustrate each other and fail to appreciate and really understand each other. You must accept the fact that the two of you are different people with your own unique qualities. Don't try to force each other to adopt your own tastes, hobbies, and interests, as it will only make matters worse.

Mary's Asc. Square Jane's Mars:

The two of you frequently approach work and goals in very different ways, and consequently you are inclined to step on each other's toes. Mary may feel that Jane is pushy or insensitive to all of the issues and concerns that are involved in a situation. You can work together very effectively, but it requires you to allow each other the freedom to approach problems in a very different way than you would. Very often you can accomplish more by working separately from each other on different aspects of a problem rather than attempting to work jointly.

Mary's Moon Square Jane's Pluto:

This relationship, especially if it is of reasonably long duration, will change both of you more profoundly than either of you would suspect at first. You share much of your personal past history and you reveal much to each other that you normally do not share with others. You may regret your candor at times, and there are qualities in each other that annoy you intensely, qualities that you do not want to acknowledge are also part

of yourself!

Mary's Mars Sextile Jane's Neptune:

You find it easy to extend yourselves and make sacrifices for each other. It is easy for you to have an abundance of good will and kind feelings for each other, and you assist each other in achieving your goals. Your religious and spiritual aspirations become more refined through this relationship, and it is easy for both of you to keep your loftier goals and spiritual ideals strong, with the support that you receive from each other.

Chapter 3 **Destiny and Final Outcome of Your Relationship**

Composite Venus Sextile Saturn:

There is a great deal of discretion, restraint, concern for propriety or proper form, and a certain subdued quality in your alliance. Both of you are sober and realistic regarding one another, unlikely to be disappointed by overblown expectations. Steadiness, constancy, and helping one another in very practical and down to earth ways make your relationship a positive, long-lasting one. It is also likely that the two of you will become involved in financial planning, a business enterprise, or a working relationship, either employee/employer, consultant/client, or co-workers.

Composite Venus Sextile Neptune:

If you are friends for a number of years, you will find that you develop similar tastes in art, music, and movies, and that you can inspire one another's imagination. You may become jointly involved in some activity that requires a lot of imagination or aesthetic sense. You also trigger each other's childish sense of awe and wonder and you will enjoy casting off your adult roles and responsibilities to enjoy life. The phrase "the only difference between men and boys is the size of their toys" may well apply to the two of you; and this phrase can apply to women as well! You may also get inspired about goals of a very humanitarian or selfless nature.

The effect that you have on each other is very positive. You inspire each other to a higher vision and grander dreams. The mutual benefits from this relationship are likely to be even greater than either of you realize.

Composite Venus Conjunct Pluto:

Over time the two of you reveal a lot about yourselves to each other and you grow to become close friends. This will not always be a smooth friendship, though, and you will go through periods where you feel like you are competing against each other instead of cooperating. Sometimes you experience power struggles where it seems that both of you think that your opinion and viewpoint is based on better values and higher standards than the other person. Unresolved emotional issues from childhood also surface and there is a tendency for at least one of you to respond to a situation based on these unresolved conflicts rather than on what is really going on now. It is likely that both of you will learn from these problems, grow up together (even if you are adults already!), and be able to resolve the problems that arise. This friendship will not be a light and casual one, but one that has a big effect on both of you.

Composite Saturn Sextile Pluto:

Together you are capable of tremendous dedication and discipline to achieve a goal. You encourage, even perhaps demand, self-control and strength in one another. You also help one another eliminate destructive habits and focus on things that are really valuable and important.

Composite Venus Conjunct Mars:

It is likely that the two of you enjoy playing games or sports together. There is a creative, fun-loving quality to your friendship that inclines you to engage in artistic, musical, or other creative endeavors. You enjoy competing against each other and also being team mates in competition against another team.

Composite Mars Sextile Neptune:

You are a good match in any game or sport, and you will find that you enjoy these kinds of activities, as well as any very creative or imaginative activity. Practical, mundane affairs are not your best area of endeavor; it is imaginative, artistic, religious, or altruistic endeavors in which the two of you can cooperate very successfully. The two of you can also succeed in affairs that are oriented towards young children or any of the arts.

The two of you inspire each other and help each other visualize more imaginative, creative, and exciting goals and dreams. The two of you can succeed in implementing a new, creative idea. You cooperate well and are understanding and tolerant towards each other, and this aids you in any endeavor that you undertake together.

Composite Mars Conjunct Pluto:

The two of you are an extremely potent force, and together you can effect enormous change (for good or ill) in your own and others' lives. Trying to force change in a willful, dominating manner or in a fanatical, intolerant way, can be very damaging, yet the drive generated between the two of you is so strong that this is definitely a potential to beware of. If either of you wills the other to improve or wishes to fundamentally alter the other's nature, furious battles will be waged between you.

There is an extremely competitive energy between you, and even if you have believed yourselves to be mild, non-aggressive people, this drive to be first and to triumph will be powerfully active with you. If you join forces to accomplish a task, nothing will stop you. If you compete solely with each other, someone is likely to get hurt - badly. These are issues that will inevitably be faced at some time in your relationship.

Composite Saturn Trine Neptune:

Even if you know one another only casually, you will find that you talk quite easily about what is really important in your lives, as well as what is hindering you or troubling you.

You can help one another meet and overcome problems. One of you may view the other as a teacher, guide, or coach in times of trouble.

Topics of a religious or spiritual nature eventually arise, and you help each other clarify your values, goals, and dreams.

Chapter 4 Other Themes in Your Relationship

Jane's Sun in Mary's 10th house:

Jane takes a keen interest in Mary's career and line of work. Jane provides encouragement and support to Mary, but may become overly concerned and meddlesome with Mary's affairs. Mary respects and may be unduly influenced by Jane's opinions.

Mary's Sun in Jane's 11th house:

You share many mutual friends, social concerns, and common ideas and interests. You may participate in group activities, or an organization, club, or community together.

Jane's Moon in Mary's 10th house:

Jane takes a great interest in Mary's career and reputation, and is likely to openly promote Mary's career, drawing recognition to Mary and "advertising" Mary's services and talents.

Mary's Moon in Jane's 3rd house:

There is a natural smoothness and ease with which Mary can express ideas and concern to Jane, which fosters a warm friendship between you.

*Jane's Mercury in Mary's 11th house,
Mary's Mercury in Jane's 11th house:*

Your intellectual rapport is very good. You share lots of ideas and interests in community affairs, political or social issues, and various clubs and organizations. In addition to your personal relationship, there is a strong feeling of camaraderie and a sense of being colleagues. You work together well in business affairs, mental work, and especially organizational planning.

Jane's Venus in Mary's 10th house:

Jane takes an active interest in Mary's career, and is very supportive. Mary appreciates Jane's help but may feel that Jane is a bit paternalistic or patronizing at times.

Mary's Venus in Jane's 12th house:

Mary seems a bit mysterious to Jane and Jane is intrigued and fascinated by Mary, but may lack trust and feel insecure with Mary. It is important to be honest and candid about feelings in this friendship, as there can be hidden feelings. There may also be a strong spiritual, almost mystical affinity for each other.

Jane's Mars in Mary's 10th house:

Jane aggressively promotes Mary's career goals and ambitions, becoming one of Mary's greatest "fans" and supporters. Jane may, however, become too pushy, demanding, and critical of Mary. Jane can become impatient with Mary, and turn 180 degrees, becoming Mary's greatest critic instead of supporter.

Mary's Mars in Jane's 12th house:

Mary pressures Jane to reveal inner, hidden traits and interests. You may irritate one another intensely at times, without knowing why.

Jane's Jupiter in Mary's 3rd house:

Jane loves talking with Mary, and, in fact, is prone to gossip a good deal with Mary. Communication is open and uninhibited between you and you find that you are able to discuss a wide variety of topics openly and freely with each other. Your conversations tend to go off in many directions with lots of digressions, and it is sometimes difficult for the two of you to stay focused on a single topic.

Mary's Jupiter in Jane's 10th house:

Circumstances develop so that Mary is able to assist Jane in career and achieving long-term goals. Mary takes a great interest in Jane's ambitions and is a great supporter and promoter of Jane's talents. You can also be very successful in business activities together. Mary encourages Jane to have more faith and confidence and to take risks in career matters.

Jane's Saturn in Mary's 6th house:

Jane influences Mary to take work, responsibilities, self-improvement and personal health matters more seriously. Mary may sometimes feel Jane is judgmental or overly critical in these areas.

Mary's Saturn in Jane's 12th house:

Issues such as death, afterlife, guilt, and religious faith come up in your conversation, even if these topics normally do not interest either of you. If either of you has any significant "emotional hang-ups" (phobias, fears, guilt, etc.), these problems will be brought to the surface in this relationship, and you will not be able to escape facing them. Mary, in particular, won't let Jane avoid these issues and brings them to the surface. The opportunity for inner growth and development presents itself but sometimes Mary increases Jane's anxieties or insecurities by probing too much.

Jane's Uranus in Mary's 10th house:

Jane has lots of original ideas on how Mary can best achieve career goals. Jane is likely to encourage Mary to take a more adventurous, risky route, and Jane often feels that Mary holds himself/herself back by being too conservative and security conscious. However, not all of Jane's ideas are well founded, and Mary must have the ability to sift out the really useful creative ideas from those that will only result in chaos and confusion.

Mary's Uranus in Jane's 1st house:

Jane's more unusual, creative side comes out in this relationship, and Jane feels more spontaneous and exuberant with Mary than with most other people. Consequently, there is a lively feeling to your relationship, but if Mary is a rather unstable person, then Jane may feel that there is not enough stability and reliability in your friendship. Mary can be somewhat disruptive in Jane's life.

Jane's Neptune in Mary's 11th house:

You are likely to become involved in social groups, political or altruistic organizations, committees, and religious groups together. A big challenge will be how to maintain a high level of integrity and honesty in these activities so that the ideals can be reached.

Mary's Neptune in Jane's 2nd house:

Mary may encourage a joint investment that proves to be unsuccessful. Mary tends to be idealistic and impractical regarding money or investments that involve Jane.

Jane's Pluto in Mary's 10th house:

If this is a long-term relationship, Jane will have a critical effect on Mary's career and ambitions. Circumstances arise that enable Jane to play a key role in helping steer Mary's career along new lines and to levels of greater stature and influence. Jane can help Mary gain a whole new outlook on career opportunities and the best way to utilize his/her own talents, but this process is a complex and tricky one, and the final outcome could be very successful or a failure, depending on how both of you handle the situation.

Mary's Pluto in Jane's 1st house:

Mary is fascinating, mysterious, almost charismatic to Jane. There is a strong desire to know each other more intimately, and share very personal experiences. You may also be prone to power struggles at times or try to manipulate one another.

Jane's Sun Square Mary's Jupiter:

Enthusiasm, optimism, and good will are very strong. Mary is able to see ways that Jane can grow, expand, and develop in practical and concrete ways as well as in attitude and inner ways. Mary, however, may try to push Jane too hastily and be deceived by unrealistic expectations, resulting in foolish joint

speculations and unsuccessful ventures. Try not to let your shared enthusiasm and optimism spawn unrealistic hopes and expectations.

Mary's Asc. Square Jane's Venus:

You enjoy recreation or fairly frivolous, self-indulgent pursuits together, which is quite pleasant for the most part. The only drawback is that you may encourage one another to be lazy, unambitious, or too extravagant.

Jane's Asc. Sextile Mary's Neptune:

Helpfulness and a mutual, unselfish concern for one another's welfare eases many of the stresses or difficulties that may come up in your relationship. You have a lot of tolerance for one another's flaws.

Jane's Moon Conjunct Mary's Venus:

Kindness, warmth, and consideration for each other are very strong. You share feelings, your pasts and family roots, personal tastes, and interests openly with each other and you understand and appreciate each other very well. This relationship grows into a close friendship.

Jane's Moon Conjunct Mary's Mars:

There is a dynamic, almost aggressive quality to your relationship. A good outlet for this energy is competitive sports and outdoor activities. You enjoy challenging each other and competing against one another. You also have the ability to accomplish a great deal together and make a dynamic working partnership - as long as you can refrain from arguing with each other.

Jane's Moon Conjunct Mary's Pluto:

If your relationship is a close one, you will find that you "get under each other's skin" and you develop strong feelings, both positive and negative, towards each other. Jane is likely to detest certain things about Mary, not realizing that these qualities are ones that Jane also shares but will not consciously admit also having! This relationship has the potential to help both of you clear away subconscious blocks and inhibitions, but you may also become only further embroiled in your own prejudices and emotional "hang-ups"; the choice is yours.

Jane's Moon Square Mary's Moon:

There are many differences in your personal habits and tastes. You are inclined to become very annoyed with each other over minor differences. Irritations over small differences of opinion and a tendency to be inconsiderate towards each other can make you both feel uncomfortable. These annoyances are not likely to lead to major upsets or seriously threaten the integrity of your relationship, but they are a nuisance. You must learn to respect the differences in your temperaments and personal habits, and strive to be aware of each other's needs.

Mary's Moon Sextile Jane's Jupiter:

Both of you get into a good mood when you are together and any personal problems or anxieties that you have feel much less oppressive. This is likely to be a long, positive and healthy friendship.

Jane's Mars Square Mary's Jupiter:

The two of you enjoy planning and designing methods for achieving success. You encourage each other to achieve your dreams and Mary frequently points out new avenues and grander vistas for Jane's talents and energy. However, the propensity to speculation and unrealistic optimism is also very strong, and many of your joint ventures are likely to prove wasteful, poorly timed, or extravagant.

Mary's Jupiter Square Jane's Uranus:

Your relationship is unlikely to become lifeless or predictable, for you continually challenge one another to grow, change, and take risks.
